



MINI GRANTS

The Behavioral Health Consortium (BHC), within the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, provides reimbursement mini-grants of up to \$2,500 (*2 requests per fiscal year allowed*) to support local, high-impact behavioral health initiatives across Delaware.

Activities must clearly align with one or more:

- Communities of Care
- Maternal Mental Health
- Community Mental Health & Substance Use Disorder
- First Responders & Veterans

Who Can Apply?

- Nonprofits & community organizations
- Schools & districts
- Healthcare & Behavioral Health Providers
- Local government entities
- Other mission-aligned organizations

Examples of Supported Activities

- Trainings & workshops
- Community awareness initiatives
- Resource navigation efforts
- Events or support programs

How It Works

1. Submit application
2. BHC grant committee reviews for eligibility
3. Decision within ~30 days

If Approved

- Simple grant agreement
- Funds distributed through state process
- Short impact summary

Before You Apply

Please review the checklist below before submitting your application. Strong applications clearly demonstrate alignment, readiness, and community impact.

ALIGNMENT

- My activity aligns with at least one BHC priority area
- The connection to behavioral health is clear and direct

PROJECT/ACTIVITY CLARITY

- I can describe the project clearly in 2–3 sentences
- The activity has a defined purpose and timeline

COMMUNITY IMPACT

- I can identify who will benefit
- The project addresses a real need in Delaware
- The impact is meaningful and realistic

BUDGET READINESS

- Costs are clear and reasonable
- We can manage and track funds responsibly for reimbursement

IMPLEMENTATION READINESS

- We are ready to begin within a reasonable timeframe
- We have the capacity to complete this project
- Key partners (if applicable) are identified

REPORTING EXPECTATIONS

- We can provide a short summary of outcomes
- We are willing to share impact highlights
