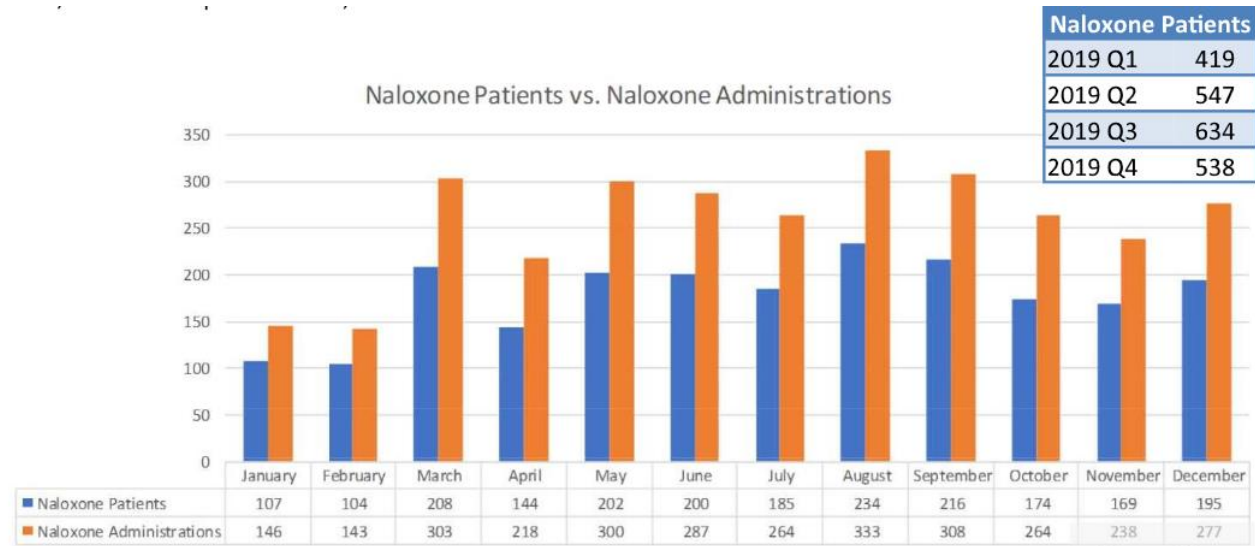

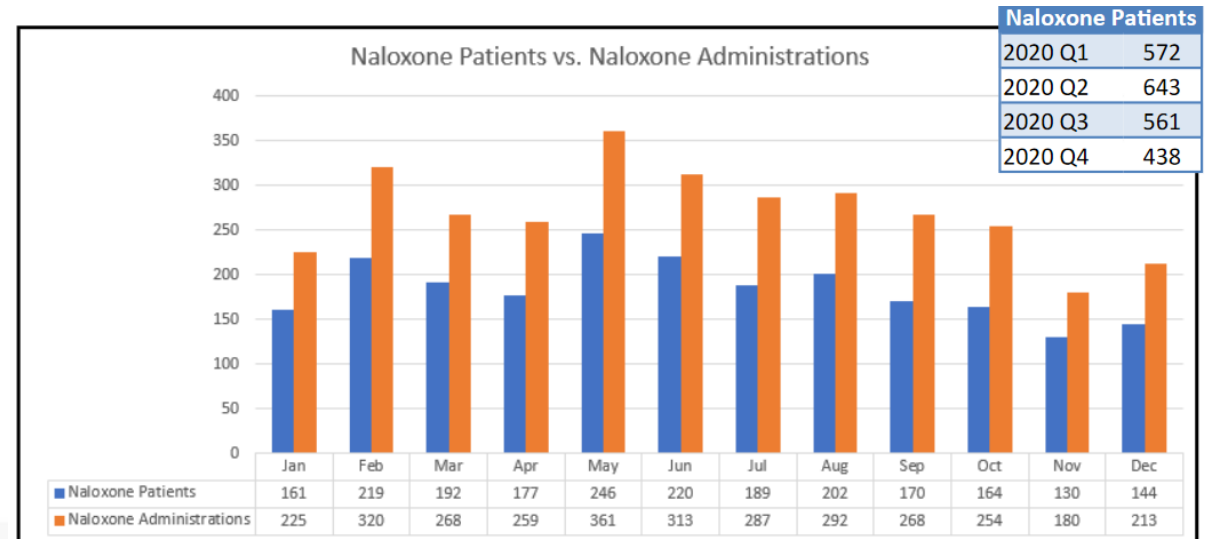

DMI Naloxone Patients vs. Administrations

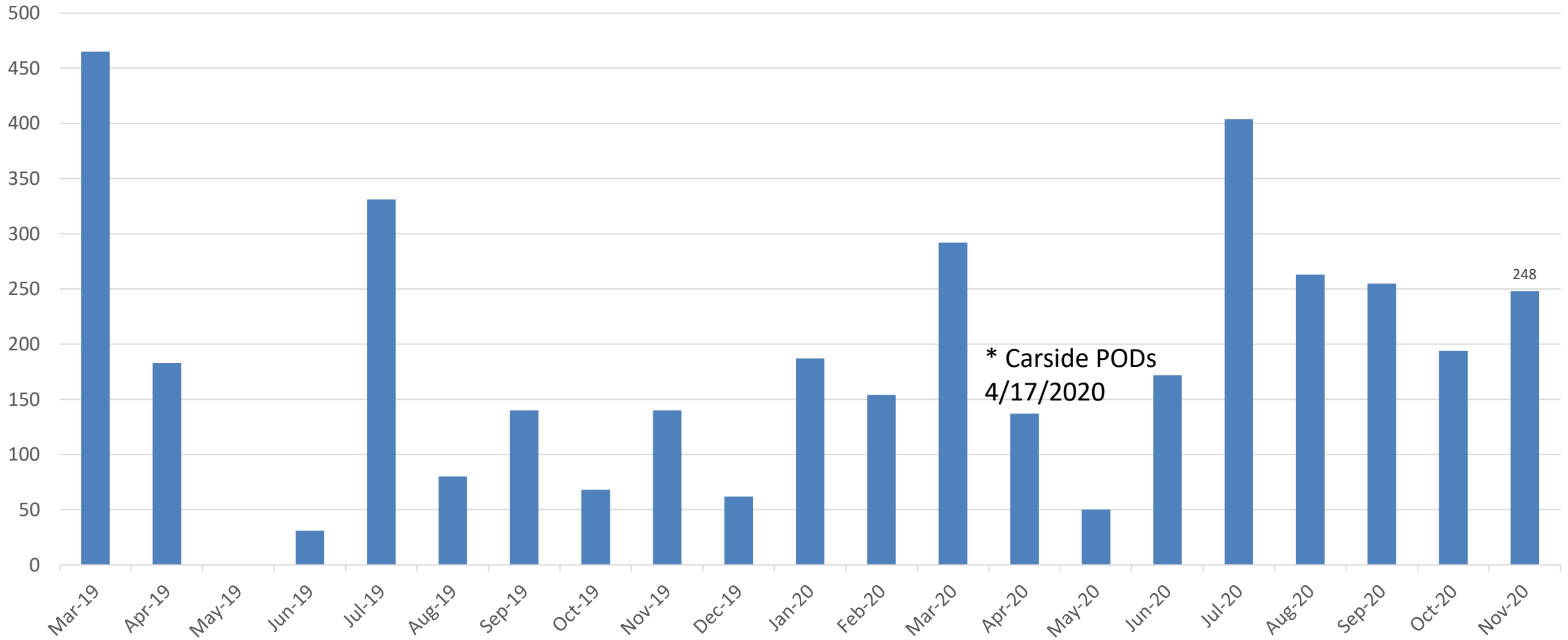
2019 EMS Trend



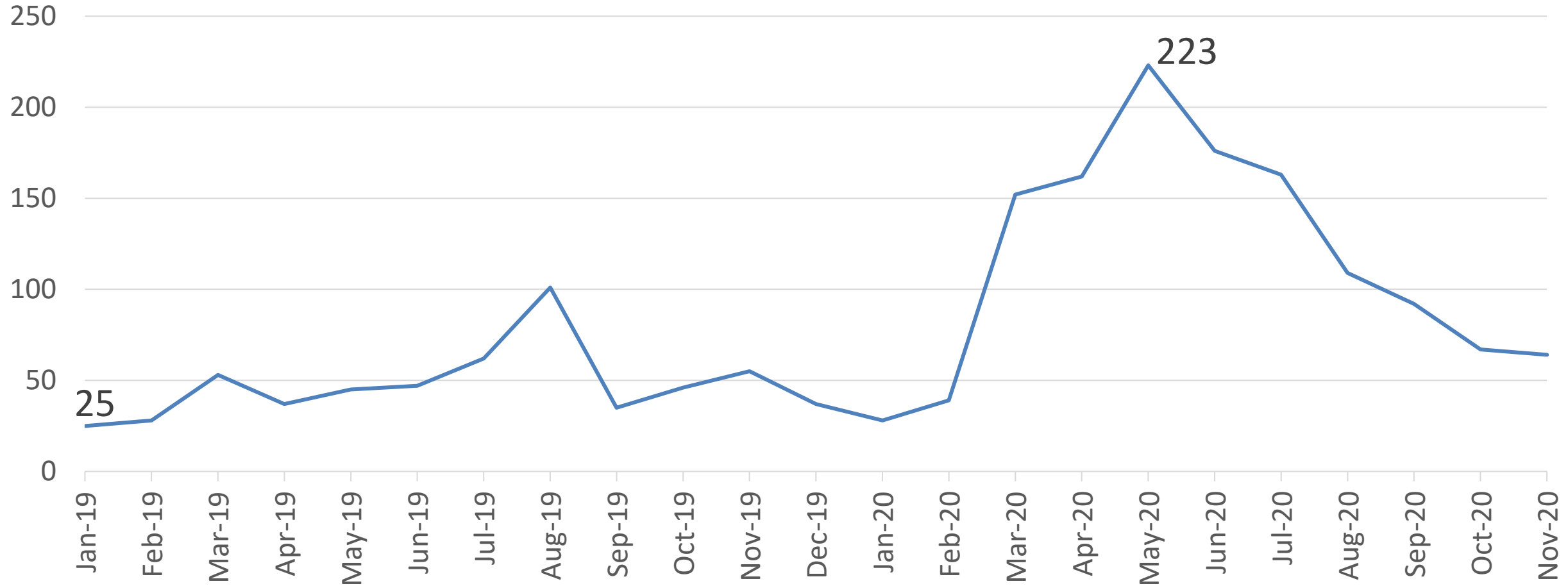
2020 EMS Trend

DPH Partnership with NEXT Distro

- Next is the first statewide online, mail-based naloxone distribution project in the U.S.
 - 35 state partnerships
- A need to get naloxone into homes
 - *Delaware Overdose Fatality Commission 2018 Annual Report*
 - 79% of overdoses happened in residence
 - **93% naloxone was not available**



Mail Order Naloxone

Naloxone at your doorstep

Delaware's Division of Public Health (DPH) has partnered with NEXT Distro, a nonprofit organization, to provide naloxone at no cost through the mail to Delaware residents who might not otherwise have access to it. The goal is to remove barriers to obtaining this lifesaving medication, which can reverse an opioid overdose.

A 2019 study by the Delaware Drug Overdose Fatality Review Commission found that 79% of the fatal overdoses it reviewed happened in a home. The commission also found that in 93% of the fatal overdoses it studied, naloxone was not available.

This program seeks to reverse that trend. Follow these steps to obtain naloxone through the NEXT Harm Reduction program:

- ✓ Go to NextDistro.org/Delaware.
- ✓ Watch the naloxone training video.
- ✓ Take the post-video test.
- ✓ Fill out a request form.
- ✓ Receive naloxone in the mail at no charge.

CDC's Overdose Data to Action (OD2A)

- **Started** in September 2019 (3-year award)
- Extended due to COVID-19 by another year (**4 years**)
- Half-way through year 2
- Applying for year 3 activities
- Continuing to work on **surveillance** and **prevention** projects



HRSA's Rural Communities Opioid Response Program- Implementation Funding Opportunity

- **Period of Performance:** September 1, 2021-August 31, 2024
- **Summary:** Focused on infusing money into community organizations to support priority focus areas (represented by the workgroups)
- **Estimated Award Amount:** \$1,000,000 over 3 years
- Application submitted March 21, 2021



CDC's Research Grants to Develop or Identify Effective Strategies to Prevent Overdose Involving Illicit Stimulants and Polysubstance Use Involving Stimulants

- **Period of Performance:** September 30, 2021-August 31, 2024
- **Summary:** Applying for Objective 2: Assess risk and protective factors for illicit stimulant use, use disorder, and overdose that can contribute to the development or adaptation of intervention strategies.
- **Estimated Award Amount:** \$362,500 per year for up to 3 years
- **Due date:** April 12, 2021



Strategic Prevention Framework for Prescription Drugs

- **Period of Performance:** September 30, 2021 up to 5 years
- **Estimated Award Amount:** \$384,000 per year
- **Summary:** Programs to raise awareness around prescription drug misuse and prevention and the risk of overprescribing to young adults.
- **Due date:** April 30, 2021
