Lt. Governor Bethany Hall-Long joined NFL Hall of Famer, and native Delawarean, Randy White at the DIAA women's high school basketball semifinals on Wednesday to announce a new statewide initiative to curb prescription drug abuse in Delaware. The "Bench Opioids" initiative is a proactive prevention and drug disposal blitz targeting opioid abuse and overdose deaths, especially among student athletes.

"We are putting on a full court press to stop prescription opioid abuse," saidLt. Governor Bethany Hall-Long, Ph.D., R.N. "I have heard from far too many

families who have an empty seat at their table due to an overdose. Thanks to the work of Dispose Rx and our state partners, we are fighting back and saving lives."

first in the Delaware.


The American Red Cross does so much for communities across Delaware and our country by providing critical support to when our
