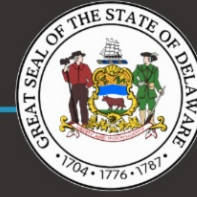

Lt. Governor Hall-Long's Statement Supporting Senate Passage of Marijuana Legalization & Regulation:

"I have been a longtime advocate for legalizing marijuana in Delaware and as a member of the General Assembly, I voted for both medical and de-criminalization legislation.

Moving forward, we need to avoid mistakes made in other states and regulate marijuana properly to keep it out of the hands of our children, to ensure product and workplace safety and to also ensure fairness for businesses and for the medical use of marijuana. There is work to be done to establish the necessary regulations to achieve these goals and a timeline that achieves the goal of safely legalizing marijuana for recreational use."

Apply to Serve on a Board

Governor Carney has appointment authority to a variety of state boards and commissions, and encourages residents to participate in state government by applying to serve on a board or commission that interests you.

If you would like to be considered for appointment to a Board or Commission, you may apply at any time regardless of whether there is a current or upcoming vacancy. Vacancies occur periodically throughout the year.

Governor Carney has announced the launch of a new website for Delaware Boards and Commissions applications. The new website will streamline the application process and provide Delawareans with the opportunity to more easily serve on Delaware's Boards and Commissions. Vacancies occur throughout the year, but Delawareans can apply at any time.
