Lt. Governor Hall-Long's Statement Supporting Senate Passage of Marijuana Legalization & Regulation:

"I have been a longtime advocate for legalizing marijuana in Delaware and as a member of the General Assembly, I voted for both medical and decriminalization legislation.

Moving forward, we need to avoid mistakes made in other states and regulate marijuana properly to keep it out of the hands of our children, to ensure product and workplace safety and to also ensure fairness for businesses and for the medical use of marijuana. There is work to be done to establish the necessary regulations to achieve these goals and a timeline that achieves the goal of safely legalizing marijuana for recreational use."


DE Women's Hall of Fame--She's On Her Way Award
