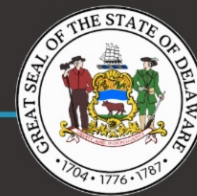

State Opioid Settlement Commission Votes on Funding Allocation



The Prescription Opioid Settlement Distribution Commission has made its first votes on where to distribute opioid settlement funding in Delaware. The Prescription Opioid Settlement Commission is an established subcommittee of Delaware's Behavioral Health Consortium and is co-chaired by Lt. Governor

Hall-Long and Attorney General Kathy Jennings. Last month, the commission voted to allocate over \$3 million to over 40 service providers across the state. Settlement funding will be used to expand resources for addiction treatment, prevention and recovery in Delaware. The commission also voted to begin the second grant phase, which will distribute \$12 million from the fund.
