Last week, I joined Delaware's congressional delegation and members of the Delaware Air National Guard to break ground on what will become a new fuel cell and corrosion control hangar. The hangar will become a critical resource for the tactical airlift mission of the 166th Airlift Wing.

As the wife of a veteran and daughter of a Guardsman, I know how important

these investments are in keeping our state and our nation safe. I applaud the work of Delaware's congressional delegation in securing \$17.5 million for the hangar, which is expected to be completed in 2025. The hangar will be a tremendous asset for the men and women of the Delaware Air National Guard who work tirelessly to defend and serve.
